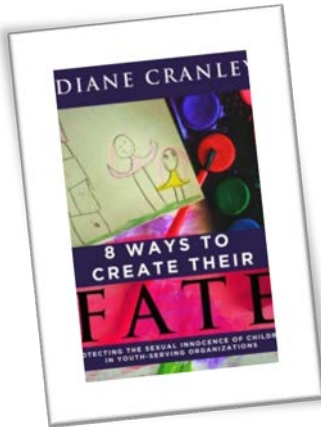


*Training Announcement:*
