

## Certified Playground Safety Inspector (CPSI) Course

SIA continues to encourage and support our member districts in providing resources for playground safety. One of those resources is the Certified Playground Safety Inspector (CPSI) certification. The CPSI course is available in person or online.

The California Park & Recreation
Society (CPRS) in conjunction with the
National Recreation and Park
Association (NRPA) are offering the
CPSI course and certification to
properly train and certify you and your
staff to recognize and prevent potential
playground hazards. Courses are
designed for school districts, park and
recreation staff, child care facilities,
installers, contractors, and more.

Candidates who successfully pass the exam will be considered a Certified Playground Safety Inspector (CPSI). Obtaining CPSI certification will meet the State of California requirements regarding the inspection of playgrounds. Recertification is required every three years.

Virtual courses require the completion of 12 hours of prerecorded learning modules and a 4-hour virtual session with a live instructor.

In-person courses are 2 days and require reading prior to the start of the course.

The 2-hour exam is administered following the completion of the course.
